- 🐾 Decisions → Guesswork



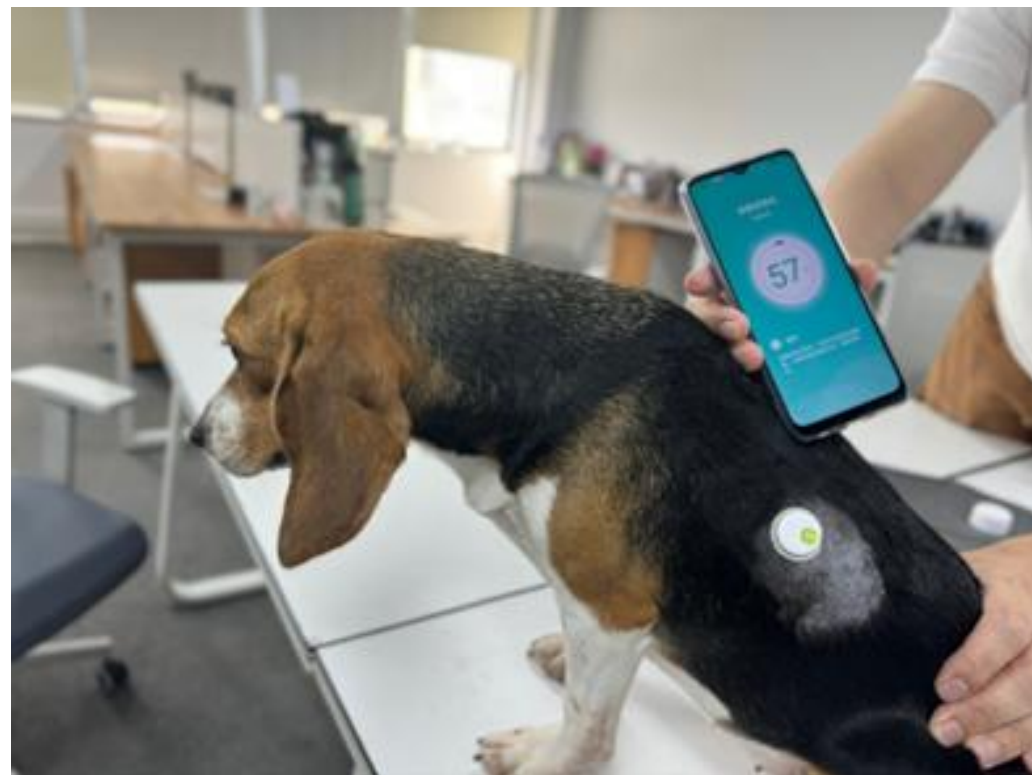
Why Use a Continuous Glucose Monitor?

Goals of a CGM

- 🐾 Reduce risk of insulin-induced hypoglycaemia

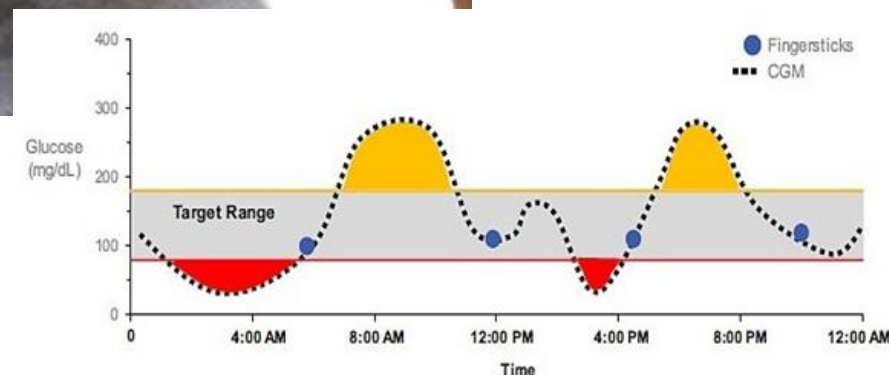
When to Use a CGM

- 🐾 Hospitalised sick diabetics



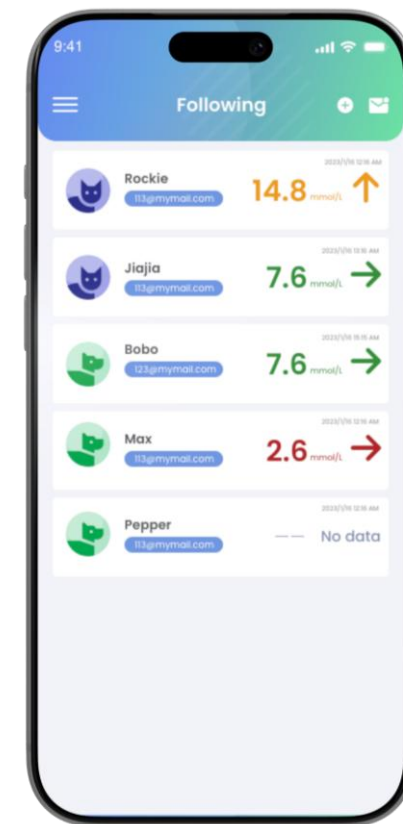
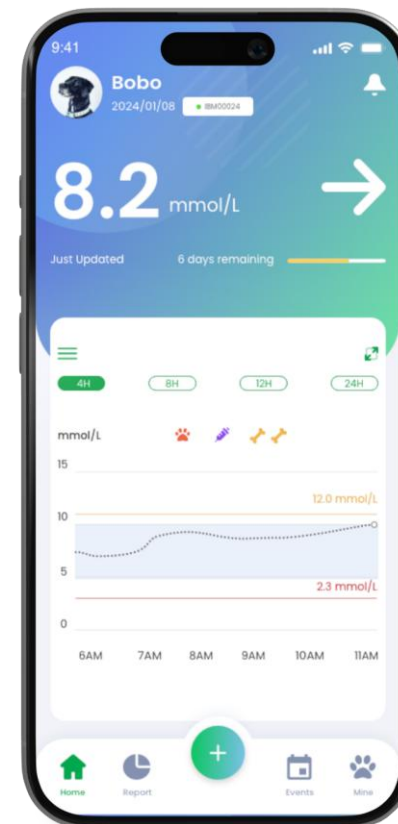
What CGM Delivers

Why use a CGM designed for human use when there's now a veterinary-specific system?

- 🐾 Specially designed calibration algorithm for cats and dogs
- 🐾 Specially designed probe for pets
- 🐾 The glucose thresholds, parameters and alert ranges are appropriate for cats and dogs
- 🐾 Higher glucose measuring range up to 42 mmol/L

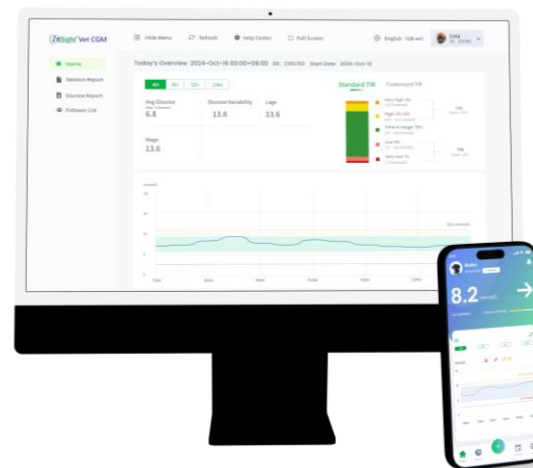
